CATC adds senior housing stop

The Casper Area Transit Coalition is adding bus stops at the Legacy Senior Residences at Elma & K streets.

"There's new senior housing on K and Elma, and that's right on the Green Route," CATC Director Marge Cole said. "We already go to the Boys Club once an hour. It's very easy to have a bus stop there."

Cole said the new stop wouldn't cost CATC any money because it's already on the existing route, and the agency has received several calls for the stop since the new facility opened last month.

"I'm surprised it went through so fast," said Carole Linton, residential manager at the site. "I think it will be extremely popular amongst all our residents since we're all seniors here. It will just make our lives a little easier and simpler."

Buses will stop on the south side at 39 minutes after each hour and on the north side at 42 minutes each hour.
