The apartments are designed with the needs of the residents in mind. The apartments are all electric with energy efficient appliances provided, including dishwasher, refrigerator, and stove so there is only one utility bill. A medical alert call system is provided in each apartment should assistance ever be required.

The housing needs of many seniors changes over time; large homes can become burdensome and can allow seniors to become isolated. As the number of seniors increases each year many seniors find themselves in need of downsizing and affordability is important in selecting a new home. Wyndam Place is designed to meet these needs providing affordability, while allowing seniors to maintain their independence in a small community setting.
